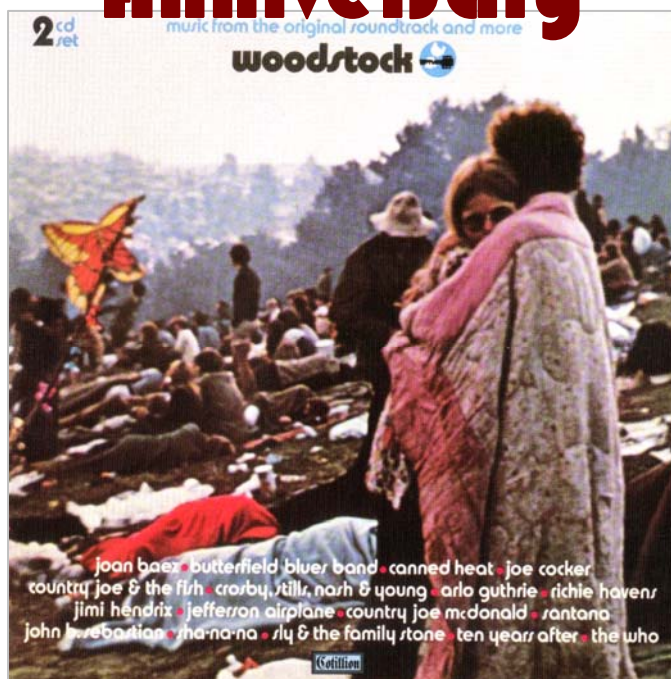

## Celebrating 40 years at Woodstock!

**The Woodstock Festival** was a music festival, billed as "An Aquarian Exposition: 3 Days of Peace & Music", held at Max Yasgur's 600-acre dairy farm in the rural town of Bethel, New York, from August 15 to August 18, 1969.



During the sometimes rainy weekend, thirty-two acts performed outdoors in front of 500,000 concert-goers. It is widely regarded as one of the greatest and most pivotal moments in popular music history and was listed on *Rolling Stone's 50 Moments That Changed the History of Rock and Roll*.

The influx of attendees to the rural concert site in Bethel created a massive traffic jam. Fearing chaos as thousands began descending on the community, Bethel did not enforce its codes. Eventually, announcements on radio stations and descriptions of the traffic jams on television news programs discouraged people from setting off to the festival. Adding to the problems and difficulty in dealing with the large crowds, recent rains had caused muddy roads and fields. The facilities were not equipped to provide sanitation or first aid for the number of people attending; hundreds of thousands found themselves in a struggle against bad weather, food shortages, and poor sanitation.

This historic three-day 1969 concert event that united close to half a million members of what came to be known as the 'Woodstock Generation', is now captured on this 40th anniversary, 2-CD reissue. While only providing a snippet of the hours of music that was presented, it also includes speeches, crowd noises, and generates a feeling that you were actually there. Performances by Richie Havens, Johnny Winter, Joan Baez, Jimi Hendrix, The Who, Santana, Jefferson Airplane, Janis Joplin, and many more are remastered from the original analog soundboard tapes making this musical time-capsule the ideal way to take a trip back to Yasgur's farm and to the performances that shaped music and popular culture for years to come.

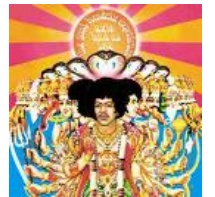
